

CODE OF CONDUCT APPENDIX 1, PROHIBITED GANG ACTIVITY

- This Appendix is intended to advise employees, volunteers, contractors, students, and visitors of the rules regarding gang-related materials and activity including hand signs, written material, symbols, and clothing while on school property, at a school function, or off school property where such materials or activity create or would foreseeably create a risk of substantial disruption to the school environment.
- Students and parents should never attempt to intervene in suspected gang activity on their own. If gang activity is suspected on school property, at a school function, or off school property where there is a nexus to the District, you should notify school administrators immediately.
- Students observed using gang signs written material, symbols, or clothing may be subject to disciplinary action in accordance with the Code of Conduct.
- Employees, volunteers, contractors, or visitors observed using or in possession of gang signs, written material, symbols, or clothing on school property, at a school function,











3. GANG RELATED CLOTHING

- The wearing or possession of clothing considered by law enforcement agencies to be gangrelated on school property, at a school function, or off school property where there is a nexus to the District is cause for disciplinary action by the South Country Central School District. The following clothing, though not intended to be all inclusive, is prohibited:
 - Any articles of clothing displaying Chicago Bulls logos;
 - Any articles of clothing displaying bright lime green colors; and any colors or company logos that are associated with gangs;
 - Any articles of clothing displaying five point crowns;
 - Any beads in the related gang
